Have you ever thought what it would have been like to have walked with Jesus when He was here on Earth? I traveled to the Holy Land experience in Florida a few years back. It was tough for me to not take that position into consideration, but I knew God has spoken. Less than a month later, I was called to my first Pastorate. Walking in the Spirit, and building on our relationship with God but being sensitive to His leading is invaluable in this life. The same Spirit that lives in the Child of God, also hovered over the void of the Earth, and when God said "Let there be", the Spirit of God made it so! That SAME Spirit, is living in us, with all the attributes of the Living God, and there to give us ACCESS to the Father. Give God a shout of Praise for the gift of His Holy Spirit.

I could talk all day about the benefits received from the Sprit. How He gifts us, through His Spirit. How His Spirit makes intercession with the Father in our behalf. When I don't know what to praythe Spirit of
